## *1st DAY - MONDAY 5th MARCH*

- ▣ *Then, the program coordinators visited an orphanage in the city and offered gifts to the children, giving them beautiful moments.*



## *4th Day – Thursday*

*On Thursday we went on a day trip and visited the famous ancient city of Ephesus, a Greek colony on the Aegean coast, with the famous 30,000-seat well-built theater built during the Hellenistic period. We admired the famous Celsus library, which at the time of its peak numbered 12,000 book volumes, as well as the ruins of the temple of Artemis between Ephesus and Selcuk.*



*We were excited to visit the house of Our Lady, a cruciform temple built by the Catholics where, according to the tradition, the Virgin Mary lived and where the Second Ecumenical Synod was convened in 431 AD. The excursion was completed with a visit and a meal at Kusadasi opposite the Greek island Samos.*



*In the evening during the dinner, the diplomas were awarded to the participants in the program.*



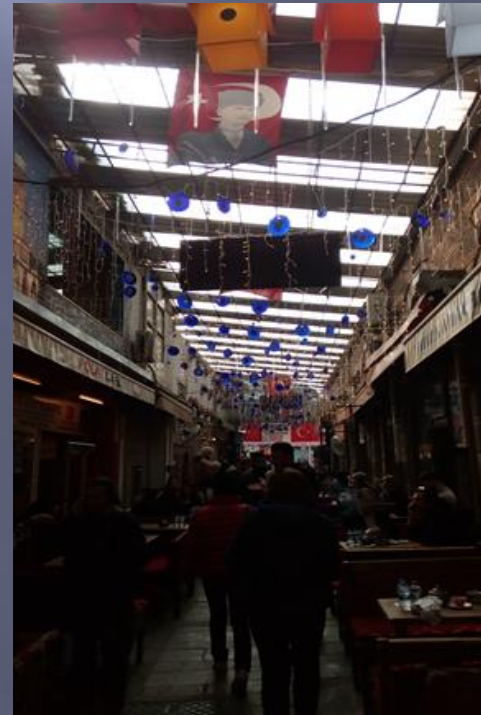


## *5th day - FRIDAY*
